EXPECT MANY CHANGES BUT THE SAME GREAT TEAM!

- Register and/or reserve your activity online prior to your visit (Max 3/week).
- Plan to arrive no more than 10 minutes before your activity. <u>Congregating in the main lobby is prohibited.</u>
- Plan a very short shower following your activity or save it until you get home.
- For sanitary reasons, both shower and change curtains have been removed.
- The use of hair dryers is prohibitted.
- · Lockers are not be available.
- The only aquatic equipment available will be personnal flottation devices (PFD) for children and belts for deep water aquafitness classes.
- Stollers are not allowed inside the civic center



PHYSICAL DISTANCING

To avoid crossovers, you will not have access to the locker rooms before your aquatic activity. You must therefore put on your swimsuit at home. Be sure to bring a large bag for your belongings. Users of the fitness room will not have access to the locker rooms.



CONCERNING THE FACE COVERING
