



## ORGANIC WASTE

**ACCEPTED**

### Food Residue

Residue of raw or cooked vegetables, meat, fish, dairy products, bones, eggs  
Cereal products, such as bread, cakes, cereals, pasta  
Coffee grounds, tea bags, condiments

### Green Residue

Residue from yard cleanup, weeding and dethatching, grass  
Residue from vegetable gardens and fruit trees  
Dead leaves, small branches

### Other Material

Soiled paper, newspapers and cartons  
Paper plates (unwaxed)  
Soiled facial tissue and paper towels (not containing cleaning solutions)  
Non-plasticized food containers (pizza boxes, paper baking cups for muffins)  
Human and animal hair, dust

**EXCLUDED**

Liquids, textiles, diapers and sanitary products (sanitary napkins, dental floss), soiled animal litter, waxed paper (ice cream containers), dryer lint, plastic containers, wood and ceramic, styrofoam, household hazardous waste, recyclable material



No plastic bags will be accepted (including biodegradable, compostable or corn-based bags).



## RECYCLABLE MATERIAL

**ACCEPTED**

### Cellulose Fibre

Newspapers, books, telephone directories, brown paper grocery bags, envelopes with or without windows  
Glossy paper (flyers, magazines)  
Fine paper (writing paper)  
Corrugated cardboard (large cartons)  
Flat cardboard (cereal boxes)  
Pulp cardboard (egg cartons)  
Waxed or multi-layered cardboard (juice containers, frozen food containers, milk cartons, TetraPak™ containers)

### Glass

Glass containers, jars and bottles, regardless of shape or colour

### Plastics (Codes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7)

Soft drink bottles, water bottles, food containers, household product containers, health and beauty containers  
Gardening pots

Plastic wrap (packing and grocery bags, shopping bags, bread bags, food bags, dry cleaner bags, rinsed milk bags)

### Metal

Containers, tin cans, beverage cans, metal lids

**EXCLUDED**

Polystyrene, diapers, aluminum or waxed paper, cellophane, soiled pizza boxes, padded envelopes, carbon paper



## REGULAR COLLECTION OF DOMESTIC REFUSE AND BULK WASTE

**ACCEPTED**

### Domestic Refuse

Diapers and sanitary napkins, dental floss, soiled animal litter, waxed paper (ice cream containers), dryer lint, styrofoam, wood and ceramic, porcelain, plastic (code 6), pressurized containers

### Bulk Waste

Furniture, carpets, mattresses, pool covers, hot water tanks  
Household appliances without doors or locks

**EXCLUDED**

All electronic and computer waste  
All recyclable material  
All organic waste  
Tires

Note: Excess volume rolling bins

Trucks are not equipped to empty rolling bins of more than 240 litres. However, if the bins contain bags that are tied, garbage collectors will empty them manually.



## ELECTRONIC WASTE DISPOSAL

**ACCEPTED**

Computers, screens, printers, television sets, radios, photocopiers, fax machines, modems, readers (VHS, DVD, CD and MP3), DVDs and CDs, cassettes (audio, VHS and others), digital cameras, video cameras, video game consoles, microwave ovens, batteries, ink cartridges, cellphones

**EXCLUDED**

Tires, household hazardous waste (paint, etc.) and other waste
