**TO QUALIFIED VOTERS ENTITLED TO BE ENTERED ON THE REFERENDUM LIST
AREA 7 OF THE CITY OF DOLLARD-DES-ORMEAUX**

HOLDING OF REGISTER CONCERNING LOAN BY-LAW R-2019-150

NOTICE is given that:

1. At a meeting held on December 16, 2019, the Council of the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux adopted the following loan by-law:

By-law R-2019-150 authorizing capital expenditures and a loan of \$2,500,000 for the reconstruction of curbs and sidewalks, and the resurfacing of Creswell, Everett, Fabre, Hilton, Linton, Sonata, Springland and Vinci Streets in Area 7.

This loan will be chargeable to all the taxpayers of area 7.
2. The qualified voters entitled to be entered on the referendum list of area 7 may request that this by-law be submitted to a referendum by entering their name, address and title supported by their signature in a register intended for this purpose. These qualified voters wishing to sign the register must establish their identity by showing one of the following documents: health-insurance card, driver's licence or Canadian passport.
3. The register will be open from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m., on January 13 and 14, 2020, at City Hall, 12001 De Salaberry Boulevard, Dollard-des-Ormeaux.
4. The number of requests needed for a referendum poll to be held concerning this by-law is 1,109. If this number is not reached, the by-law will be considered approved by the qualified voters.
5. The by-law and the illustration of area 7 may be consulted at City Hall, during regular office hours, from Monday to Friday and on the City Website.
6. The result of the registration procedure will be announced in the Council Room on January 14, 2020, at 7 p.m., or as soon as available.

CONDITIONS TO BE A QUALIFIED VOTER HAVING THE RIGHT TO BE ENTERED ON THE REFERENDUM LIST OF AREA 7:

1. Be a person who, on December 16, 2019, is not disqualified to vote as defined in Section 524 of *An Act Respecting Elections and Referendums in Municipalities* and who fulfils the following conditions:
 - be a natural person domiciled in the city and have been domiciled in Quebec for at least 6 months; and
 - be of legal age and a Canadian citizen and not be under curatorship.
2. Be a non-resident sole owner of an immovable or sole occupant of a business establishment situated in the concerned area who has not been disqualified to vote and fulfils the following conditions:
 - be the sole owner of an immovable or sole occupant of a business establishment for at least 12 months;
 - in the case of a natural person, be of legal age and a Canadian citizen and not under curatorship.
3. Be a non-resident undivided co-owner of an immovable or a non-resident co-occupant of a business establishment situated in the concerned area who has not been disqualified to vote and fulfils the following conditions:
 - be an undivided co-owner of an immovable or co-occupant of a business establishment for at least 12 months;
 - be designated by power of attorney signed by the majority of the persons that have been co-owners or co-occupants for at least 12 months, as the one entitled to sign the register on their behalf and to be entered on the referendum list of the concerned area. The power of attorney must have been produced or be produced at the signature of the register.
4. A legal person must have designated by resolution, amongst its members, directors or employees, a person who is, on December 16, 2019, and upon exercising any of those rights, be of legal age, be a Canadian citizen and be neither under curatorship nor disqualified from voting as defined by Law.
