MINOR EXEMPTION TO THE CITY OF DOLLARD-DES-ORMEAUX ZONING BY-LAW 82-704

NOTICE is given as follows:

At a regular meeting to be held on July 6, 2021, at 7:30 p.m., Council will approve a request for a minor exemption to zoning by-law 82-704, in order for the following immovable to comply with the provisions of *An Act Respecting Land Use Planning and Development*:

Affected immovable

Building at 397 Monet Street
Cadastre No. 2 375 625

Nature of the exemption

To allow a rear setback (north-west) of the inground swimming pool of 1.41 m (\pm 4.63 ft) instead of the required minimum rear distance of 1.52 m (5 ft) and this, for the useful life of the inground swimming pool.

In accordance with Decree 2020-049, any procedure that involves the movement or gathering of citizens, which is part of the decision-making process of the Municipal Council, is replaced with a 15-day written consultation announced beforehand by public notice.
