

Voting by mail: 2021 municipal election

Can you vote by mail?

You can vote by mail if you are in one of the following situations:

- Your domicile is located in the municipality, and you are unable to travel for health reasons. Your caregiver
 domiciled at the same address can also vote by mail.
- You are in isolation as ordered or recommended by public health authorities because you:
 - Returned from a trip abroad within the last 14 days;
 - Were diagnosed with COVID-19 and you are still considered a carrier of the disease;
 - Are showing COVID-19 symptoms;
 - Have been in contact with a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19 within the last 14 days;
 - Are waiting for a COVID-19 test result.
- You are in a residential care centre or a health care facility, i.e.:
 - You are living in a private seniors' residence identified in the register established under the *Act respecting health services and social services*.
 - You are living in a residential and long-term care centre (CHSLD), a hospital or a rehabilitation centre.
- You are 70 years of age or older on polling day.

How can you apply?

The request may be **submitted in writing** by completing the *Request Form to Vote by Mail* and sending it to us:

- By email at elections@DDO.qc.ca;
- By mail to the attention of the Assistant to the Returning Officer; or
- In person, by leaving it in the mailbox at door #2 of the Dollard-des-Ormeaux Civic Center.

The request may also be **submitted verbally**, by calling 514 684-1012 poste 237.

For residents living in a designated residential care centre or health care facility, forms will be given to those in charge of the center or facility and they will be collected by the Returning Officer's staff. You may also submit your request verbally, by calling 514 684-1012 poste 237.

To vote by mail, you must apply on or before Wednesday, October 27, 2021.

▶ If you are isolating, you can ask to vote by mail starting October 17, 2021, only.

Eligible persons who have made a request to vote by mail will receive an envelope containing the ballot. Completed ballot papers must be received at the Returning Officer's office on or before Friday, November 5, 2021, at 4:30 p.m.

If you are eligible to vote by mail, you can also seek a change to the list of electors in writing.

If you are isolating, your application to vote by mail will be valid only for the November 7, 2021, election. For other electors eligible to vote by mail, your application will be valid for the November 7, 2021, election and for any recommenced proceedings arising from this election.
