PUBLIC NOTICE

CONVOCATION TO A REGISTER ON RESOLUTION PP-029

TO QUALIFIED VOTERS ENTITLED TO HAVE THEIR NAME ENTERED ON THE REFERENDUM LIST OF THE CONCERNED SECTOR (ZONE R-2f)

- 1. At a sitting held on December 13, 2022, Council approved Resolution PP-029 entitled "Resolution PP-029 relating to an authorization request under the provisions of By-law R-2013-085 concerning specific construction, alteration or occupancy proposals for an immovable (SCAOPI) 35-37 Brunswick Boulevard, lot 2 262 952 (zone R-3r)".
- 2. Qualified voters entitled to have their name entered on the referendum list of zone R-2f may request that the said Resolution be submitted to a referendum poll by entering their name, address and capacity in a register open for that purpose and affixing their signature opposite those entries.
- 3. The said register will be open for registration from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. on January 18, 2023, at the City Clerk's Office, 12001 De Salaberry Boulevard, Dollard-des-Ormeaux.
- 4. The number of applications needed to require that the resolution be subject to a referendum poll be held is **269**. If the required number is not reached, the Resolution will be deemed approved by the qualified voters.
- 5. The results of the registration procedure will be announced at the City Clerk's Office, on January 18, 2023, at 7 p.m.
- 6. The said Resolution may be examined in the City Clerk's Office, 12001 De Salaberry Boulevard, Dollard-des-Ormeaux, during office hours, from Monday to Friday and during registration hours or on the City's website at https://ville.ddo.gc.ca/en/my-city/municipal-by-laws/draft-by-laws/.
- 7. Conditions to be a qualified voter having the right to be entered on the referendum list of zone R-2f:
- 7.1 Be a person who, on December 13, 2022, is not disqualified to vote as defined in Section 524 of *An Act Respecting Elections and Referendums in Municipalities* and who fulfils the following conditions:
 - be a natural person domiciled in zone R-2f and have been domiciled in Quebec for at least 6 months; and
 - be of legal age and a Canadian citizen and not be under curatorship.
- 7.2 Be a non-resident sole owner of an immovable or sole occupant of a business establishment situated in zone R-2f who has not been disqualified to vote and fulfils the following conditions:
 - be the sole owner of an immovable or sole occupant of a business establishment for at least 12 months;
 - in the case of a natural person, be of legal age and a Canadian citizen and not under curatorship.
- 7.3 Be a non-resident undivided co-owner of an immovable or a non-resident co-occupant of a business establishment situated in zone R-2f who has not been disqualified to vote and fulfils the following conditions:
 - be an undivided co-owner of an immovable or co-occupant of a business establishment for at least 12 months;
 - be designated by power of attorney signed by the majority of the persons that have been co-owners or co-occupants for at least 12 months, as the one entitled to sign the register on their behalf and to be entered on the referendum list of zone R-2f. The power of attorney must have been produced or be produced at the signature of the register.
- 7.4 A legal person must have designated by resolution, amongst its members, directors or employees, a person who is, on December 13, 2022, and upon exercising any of those rights, be of legal age, be a Canadian citizen and be neither under curatorship nor disqualified from voting as defined by Law.

MANDATORY IDENTIFICATION

A qualified voter must establish its identity be presenting one of the following documents:

- a health-insurance card issued by the Régie de l'assurance-maladie du Québec
- a Québec driver's license or probationary license
- a Canadian passport
- a certificate of Indian Status
- a Canadian Armed Forces identification
