Revision of the Urban Planning Programme of the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux

Dollard-des-Ormeaux, March 28th, 2024 —As part of the participatory process for the revision of its Urban Planning Programme, the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux is pleased to invite its citizens to an Open House on Thursday **April 4th, from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m., and on Saturday April 6th, from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m., in Entrance 4 of the Civic Centre to present the preliminary orientations of the Urban Planning Programme.**

Through a series of citizen participation activities that brought together hundreds of voices in the fall of 2023, **the City has defined preliminary proposals for the future Urban Planning Programme, that take into account the experiences, needs and suggestions of its citizens.** These transformation strategies can be viewed in video format on our [website](#), in the section entitled “The Revision of the Urban Planning Programme : Context and Preliminary Proposals”.

To ensure transparency and information sharing, a press briefing was held on Tuesday March 26th to respond to questions from the media. Residents will have a similar opportunity, at the Open House organized for this purpose. This event will provide citizens with an **opportunity to learn more about the preliminary proposals and to speak directly with our municipal professionals who have worked tirelessly to integrate the wishes of the population into the new Urban Planning Programme.**

“The main goal of this programme is to produce a final urban plan which is **designed by Dollard residents for Dollard residents while ensuring the protection of our quality of life.** I am truly proud of the incredible engagement and support we've witnessed from our residents every step of the way.
