PUBLIC NOTICE

DRAFT BY-LAW CONCERNING THE TERRITORY DIVISION OF THE CITY INTO EIGHT (8) ELECTORAL DISTRICTS

To all electors of the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux:

NOTICE is hereby given that at a regular meeting held on April 9, 2024, the Municipal Council adopted draft by-law R-2024-188 entitled "BY-LAW CONCERNING THE DIVISION OF THE CITY OF DOLLARD-DESORMEAUX TERRITORY INTO EIGHT (8) ELECTORAL DISTRICTS".

This draft by-law divides the territory of the municipality into eight electoral districts, each represented by a Councillor, and delimits these districts in such a manner as to ensure a balance in the number of electors for each of them and that each has the greatest possible socio-economic homogeneity.

The description of the electoral districts boundaries has been done clockwise by using traffic lanes when possible. The use of the words Boulevard, Avenue, Street and high-tension line, implies their median line, unless otherwise indicated. The use of a rear limit of a traffic lane shall mean that the boundary of the electoral district runs at the back of the lots fronting the traffic lane mentioned. The side of said lane is specified by a cardinal point.

The electoral districts are delimited as follows:

Electoral district number 1 (4,260 electors)

Starting at the intersecting point of the south-west municipal boundary and the high-tension line, that high tension line, the continuation of Hastings Street, that street, Westminster, Lake, Fenwood and Mozart Streets, Kennebec Street and its continuation to the high-tension line, that high tension line, Thornhill and Tecumseh Streets and the south-east and south-west municipal boundary back to the starting point.

Electoral district number 2 (4,180 electors)

Starting at the intersecting point of the north-west municipal boundary and Saint-Jean Boulevard, that boulevard, Westminster Street, Hastings Street and its continuation, the high-tension line and the south-west, west and north-west municipal boundary back to the starting point.

Electoral district number 3 (5,028 electors)

Starting at the intersecting point of Saint-Jean Boulevard and the north-west municipal boundary, that boundary, Anselme-Lavigne Avenue, Gariépy and Radisson Streets, Newton Street and its continuation, Fredmir, Roger-Pilon, Baffin, Barton, Dauphin and Lake Streets, and Saint-Jean Boulevard back to the starting point.

Electoral district number 4 (4,602 electors)

Starting at the intersecting point of Anselme-Lavigne Avenue and of the north-west municipal boundary, this boundary, the north-east municipal boundary, des Sources Boulevard, Roger-Pilon, Mulberry, Woodlawn, Canterbury, Roger-Pilon, Westpark and Wilson Streets, the rear limit of Manuel Street (north-east and north-west sides), Fredmir Street, the continuation of Newton Street, that street, Radisson and Gariépy Streets and Anselme-Lavigne Avenue back to the starting point.

Electoral district number 5 (4,514 electors)

Starting at the intersection of Manuel and Fredmir Streets, that street, the rear limit of Manuel Street (north-west and north-east sides), Wilson, Westpark, Lake and Donnacona Streets, the rear line of lots fronting Donnacona Street (west side), the high tension line, Lake Street, the south-east and south-west municipal boundary, Tecumseh and Thornhill Streets, the high tension line, the continuation of Kennebec Street, that street, Mozart, Fenwood, Lake, Dauphin, Barton, Baffin, Roger-Pilon and Fredmir Streets back to the starting point.

Electoral district number 6 (4,424 electors)

Starting at the intersecting point of des Sources Boulevard and of the north municipal boundary, this boundary, the continuation of Forest Street to the north, that street, Hyman Street, Angora Street and its continuation, the high tension line, the rear line of lots fronting Donnacona Street (west side), Lake, Westpark, Roger-Pilon, Canterbury, Woodland, Mulberry and Roger-Pilon Streets and des Sources Boulevard back to the starting point.

Electoral district number 7 (4,291 electors)

Starting at the intersecting point of the continuation to the north of Forest Street and of the north municipal boundary that boundary, the north-east and east municipal boundary, the high-tension line, the continuation of Angora Street, that street, Hyman Street, Forest Street and its continuation back to the starting point.

Electoral district number 8 (4,144 electors)

Starting at the intersecting point of Lake Street and the high-tension line, that high tension line, the east and south-east municipal boundary and Lake Street back to the starting point.

NOTICE is also given that all electors, according to Section 17 of the *Act respecting Elections and Referendums in municipalities* (CQLR, Chapter E-2.2), can, in the fifteen (15) days of the publication of this notice, express their opposition in writing. This opposition must be addressed to:
