

## Resilience project to modernize the power distribution system

### Nature and description of the work

Over the next few weeks, as part of its project to improve the quality of electricity service, Hydro-Québec will rebuild the distribution line in your area to install new equipment.

The work will involve:

- Excavation and installation of new poles, including vegetation control around the lines, as necessary.
- Transfer of electrical equipment to new poles.
- Transfer of telecommunications equipment by carriers.
- Removal of old poles once the equipment transfers are complete.

### Work area

- Between Rue Alie, Rue Drouin and Avenue Anselme-Lavigne, in Hydro-Québec's distribution line right-of-way.

### Impact of the work

- Work carried out by Hydro-Québec employees or representatives in the servitude right-of-way.
- Removal of parking spaces in the area.
- Noise from machinery during certain operations.

### Mitigation measures

- If real and visible damage is caused to property, it will be evaluated and compensated.
- Appropriate signage.
- Uninterrupted access to residences and businesses.

### Project schedule

- August 26 to December 31, 2024.  
*\*The transfer of telecommunications equipment and removal of old poles will be finalized in 2025. Hydro-Québec will provide further information before the start of the work to remove the poles.*
- Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m.  
Work may also be carried out on Saturday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Affected property owners will be notified, as necessary.

**Note: The work will entail service interruptions. All affected customers will be notified ahead of time.**
