



Quality of drinking water in relation to the presence of lead

Action plan

Update no. 2, November 15, 2024

The 2024 sampling campaign to detect the presence of lead and copper in the two drinking water distribution networks serving the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux (from Pierrefonds and Pointe-Claire) has been completed.

Based on maximum acceptable concentrations (MACs) and sampling carried out in accordance with prescribed methods, results were compliant at all sampling locations for both distribution networks.

The City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux will communicate the results to the homeowners where the samples were taken, in accordance with the *Guide d'évaluation et d'intervention relatif au suivi du plomb et du cuivre dans l'eau potable*.

Consequently, the action plan produced on July 6, 2023 remains unchanged.

Publication

In accordance with the provisions of Section 36.2 of the Regulation respecting the quality of drinking water (RLRQ c Q-2, r.40), a copy of this updated action plan:

- has been published on the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux website;
- has been made available to the *ministre de l'Environnement, de la Lutte aux changements climatiques, de la Faune et des Parcs*; and
- is available to any user of the City of Dollard-des-Ormeaux's drinking water distribution system who requests it.
